(TextMaker bindings vs Standard Mac bindings - grey cells are correct; but yellow need to conform to Mac, so that Mac users can enjoy using TextMaker for Mac)

**Two** binding options should be available: Standard Mac, or Standard Windows, with Home/End, PgU/PgD in each binding set to the Standard Mac or Standard Windows use of those keys, as well as Ctrl and Alt combinations with them. Shift should simply select whatever the key already does in terms of cursor movement (or scrolling). BOL/EOL = Beginning/End of Line. TOD/BOD = Top/Bottom of Document. BO/EO-¶ = Begin/End of ¶.
